1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the 2021 - 2024 *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. The rules of the IFDCA will also apply

2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY and REGISTRATION:

2.1 All boats of the following classes are invited to participate.

Vanguard 15 July 29th
Laser July 29th

- 2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing the Regatta entry form and paying the entry fee.
- 2.3 The entry fee for the

Flying Dutchman 3-day regatta - \$130 per boat. Vanguard 15 1-day regatta - \$60 per boat Laser 1-day regatta - \$35 per boat

- 2.4 5 or more boats in each class will have their own start.
- 2.5 Flying Dutchman will race Saturday and Sunday if fewer than 5 FDs are registered by July 1st, 2023.
- 2.6 The 1-day regatta for the other boats will continue regardless of the FD participation.

- **5. <u>SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:</u>** Sailing Instructions will be available at CYC at registration, and by Sunday July 16th on the club web site @: https://www.sailcyc.com/raceevents.cfm?subpage=1216642

- **6. RACING AREA and COURSES:** The racing area will be on Canandaigua Lake. The courses shall be windward leeward or triangle-windward-leeward and will use temporary Club buoys. In the round the buoy's races the target time for the first boat to finish is 45 minutes.
- **7. SCORING:** The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A of the *RRS*, will apply A minimum of one race must be sailed to constitute a regatta.
- **9. LAUNCHING:** Boats may be rigged and stored on the blacktop at CYC for the duration of the regatta and ramp or hoist launched.
- **10. PRIZES:** In addition to some novelty awards, first through third place finishers will be awarded for both helm and crew for the FDs.

Number of awards for each of the other 2 fleets will be determined by number of registrants.

- 11. <u>DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:</u> Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. RRS rule 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 12. **INSURANCE:** Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third party liability insurance
